Dairy Products: Taiwan Zoosanitary Certification

**CTO Direction to Biosecurity Inspectors for the Clearance of Dairy Products from Taiwan**

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Vicki Melville, Manager Animal Trade, Ministry for Primary Industries (under delegated authority), give the following directions for dairy products to be given clearance in accordance with the following measures, different from those in the applicable *Import Health Standard: Dairy Products and Products containing Dairy Ingredients from Specified Countries* (DAIEDIIC.SPE, 1 September 2011)

MPI recognises Taiwan Food and Drug Administration (TFDA) as a competent authority and accepts the dairy specimen certificate for the use of importing dairy products from Taiwan.  
The certificate won't be signed by the Official Veterinarian, but the original will be stamped with the head of the TFDA name stamp.

The reason for directing clearance is that the biosecurity risks associated with this CTO direction have been assessed and are managed effectively.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and continues in effect until amended or revoked.
