1 Malaysia Review Audit of New Zealand Red Meat Establishments

1.1 Scope

1. The Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) has received notification from the Department of Veterinary Services (DVS) and the Department of Islamic Development (JAKIM) requesting to conduct an onsite review audit of New Zealand's establishments currently approved to export meat and meat products to Malaysia.
2. The dates proposed for the audit are from the **7 October 2019 to 18 October 2019**.
3. MPI has been informed that the scope of this audit covers those establishments currently [listed for export of meat and meat products to Malaysia](#), who are due for their three yearly review audit. Establishments which are included in this review audit will be contacted directly by MPI Verification Services.
4. Any questions regarding Malaysia's processing requirements, as detailed in the [Malaysian OMAR and 17/39 Malaysia: Meat and Meat Products Halal Requirements](#), should be directed to MPI Verification Services (VS) in the first instance.

1.2 Pre-audit Documentation

1. DVS and JAKIM have requested for establishments included in this review audit to fill out the required pre-audit documentation. There are two forms to be completed, one for DVS and one for JAKIM respectively.
2. MPI will provide establishments with the necessary documentation, including guidance materials.
3. The DVS form is to be countersigned by the MPI VS onsite Veterinary Technical Supervisor (VTS). The JAKIM form is to be countersigned by the establishments Malaysia listed Approved Halal Organisation (AHO), and a colour scanned copy provided back to the establishments' MPI VS Veterinary Technical Supervisor.
4. Scanned colour copies of the completed original DVS and JAKIM forms, and associated attachments, will be consolidated by the onsite MPI VS Veterinary Technical supervisor, and submitted to market.access@mpi.govt.nz with the premises identifier and "Malaysia Audit 2019" in the subject field of the email. Due date for submission of completed pre-audit documentation is the **21 June 2019**.
5. Original copies of these forms should be kept on site by the operator at each establishment
