

CTO Direction to MPI Inspector

CTO direction code for recording in Quantum: CTOPlants20190002: On-arrival treatment of non-compliant consignment C2018/500926 (CN: FCIU4691195) of 43 containerised used motorcycles and scooters from Japan as being equivalent to the requirements of the Import Health Standard for Vehicles, Machinery and Equipment.

Pursuant to section 27(1)(d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Paul Hallett, give the following directions for clearance of used motorcycles and scooters that have not been managed via an MPI-Approved System or treated before arrival in New Zealand.

1. The used motorcycles and scooters must be treated in accordance with appropriate measures for vehicles and machinery as specified in MPI Standard - *MPI Approved Biosecurity Treatments*.
2. Treatment must be conducted at the place of first arrival (or at a transitional facility).
3. After treatment has been conducted, an MPI Inspector must conduct a verification inspection of the motorcycles and scooters to confirm compliance with the intent of the Import Health Standard for Vehicles, Machinery and Equipment.
4. After compliance with the Import Health Standard for Vehicles, Machinery and Equipment has been confirmed, the consignments (as above) may be provided with biosecurity clearance.

This direction takes effect from the date of signing and only applies to consignment C2018/500926 (CN: FCIU4691195).
