CTO Direction to an MPI Inspector

CTO DIRECTION DOCUMENT: CTOPlants2019046 – Equivalent on-arrival treatment for Brown Marmorated Stink Bug (BMSB) for the following non-compliant risk goods when already landed;

- 1. Vehicles, machinery and parts in a fully sealed sea container from BMSB risk countries; or
- 2. Fully sealed sea containers (and inner risk cargo) from Italy.

Pursuant to section 27(1) (d)(iii) of the Biosecurity Act 1993 I, Paul Hallett, give the following direction for measures, different from those required by Part 4 of the Import Health Standard: Vehicles, Machinery and Parts and Section 2.3 of the Import Health Standard for Sea Containers from All Countries.

The non-compliant risk goods may be given biosecurity clearance if the following procedure is followed:

- 1. Treatment must be conducted as per *MPI Technical Standard Approved Biosecurity Treatments* at a Port or First Arrival or a suitable Transitional Facility by an MPI-Approved Treatment Supplier (as soon as possible).
- 2. All other relevant requirements of the *Import Health Standard for Vehicles, Machinery and Parts* or the *Import Health Standard for Sea Containers from All Countries* must be met.

CTOD2019046 remains valid or the 2019/2020 BMSB season or until such time as it is revoked or the applicable requirements of the *VEHICLE.ALL* and *SEACO* standards are changed to make this direction non-applicable.
