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Notice

1 Title

This notice is the Animal Products (Requirement for Recognised Agencies to Notify of Termination of Contract) Notice 2008.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 5 June 2008.

3 Requirement

- (1) All recognised risk management programme verifying agencies must notify the Director-General in writing of the termination of any contractual arrangement with a client (including an operator) for the provision of verification functions and activities.
- (2) The notification must be made in accordance with section 36(2) of the Animal Products Act 1999 and therefore must be made as soon as practicable, and in no case later than 7 days after termination.

Explanatory Note

This notice provides that all recognised risk management programme verifying agencies must notify the Director-General in writing of the termination of any contractual arrangement with a client (including an operator) for the provision of verification functions and activities.
