

## FoodPlus Quarterly Progress Report – October - December 2014

The FoodPlus programme has now completed its seventh quarter of activity, and ANZCO has invested \$3.7m to date.

- 1. Two food products have reached commercialisation decisions, and are now being commercialised outside FoodPlus.
- 2. A total of eight products have now moved from development within the FoodPlus programme, to commercialisation by ANZCO or TBE. All these products use lower value raw materials, with value added by knowledge developed in the programme.
- 3. The commercialised products include two ingredient products, two food products, one healthcare product and three blood-derived products commercialised through ANZCO's joint venture with Bovogen Biologicals.
- 4. A range of food products continue to be developed and tested with customers.
- 5. Taranaki Bio Extracts continues to work with customers in global markets to commercialise ingredient products.
- 6. The commercialised food products underwent initial development at the ANZCO Innovation Centre at Lincoln University, and that facility continues to work on new products and technologies for a number of projects within the programme.
- 7. ANZCO continues to work with customers and potential partners within the Healthcare area.
- 8. A protein based product has been shipped to an overseas supplier for market trials.
