QUARTERLY PROGRESS SUMMARY: April – June 2015

High Performance Manuka Plantations PGP Programme

Summary of progress during this quarter

- Annual analysis of nectar sample from all trail sites has been completed
- Full statistical analysis has been completed on the nectar collected and analysed for the 2014/2015 season.
- A full report of all information for each of the trial sites and plantation data has been completed.
- A single secured database has been created and houses data collected from the research projects and trial sites.

Key highlights and achievements

- Two further papers ready to submit to scientific journals: (1) Manuscript describing 10 genotypes
 on 1 soil type results, and (2) 'spectroscopy' manuscript focused on analytical methods to
 measure sugars and DHA in nectar. Genetic and environmental influences on nectar composition
 and yield in Leptospermum scoparium (mānuka).
- The first iteration of a Research Field manual has been completed. This is a standard set of guidelines for sampling and monitoring manual field plantations throughout the PGP programme.
- Draft Technical notes have been developed, these notes discuss core technical aspects involving preparation, planting and managing high performance manuka plantations.
- An oral poster presentation at the combined NZIAHS & NZIAPB 'Plants for the Future'
 Conference (1-3 July 2015 at Massey University, Palmerston North) "Genetic Constraints of High
 Performance Manuka".

Collaboration with other PGP programmes

 Knowledge gained from analytical techniques developed in PhD studies in the m\u00e4nuka PGP programme are being applied to Transforming the Dairy Value Chain PGP project.

Upcoming

- The programme continues with the increased intensity in terms of project work, its oversight and management.
- Increase in intensity to produce the commercialisation plan
- Development of web presence for distribution of high performing m\u00e4nuka seedlings and PGP information.
